

Roseville Area High School Home School Education Policy

DEFINITION of Home School Student

Students who are provided instruction at home in compliance with sections 120.101 and 120.102 of the Minnesota Statutes regarding Compulsory Instruction.

FULL-TIME HOME EDUCATED STUDENTS:

Students who choose to be full-time home educated, grades 9-12, will not receive a diploma from Roseville Area High School.

ROSEVILLE AREA HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OPTION: *

Home educated students may earn a diploma from Roseville Area High School if they are enrolled at least part time during their senior year of high school.

- Students must meet the Local and State graduation requirements
- Students must submit home education credits to the high school at the beginning of the senior year to determine eligibility for graduation.
- Credits submitted must come directly from the home school or the publisher or organization that evaluates the curriculum being used for home school. Documentation including description of curriculum, instructional process, and methods used for assessment will be used by the high school counselor to determine credits eligible for transfer.
- Credits from the home school will be entered on the student's official transcript as Home School credits and will be transferred into trimester credits and will count towards meeting Local graduation requirements.

* The State of Minnesota, beginning with the ninth grade class of 2006-2007, requires passing scores in written composition, reading, and mathematics in order to receive a Minnesota High School Diploma.
