Policy 800 – Community Education

1.0 Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to convey to employees and to the general public the important role of community education within the school district.

2.0 General Statement of Policy

The school board affirms a strong commitment to the community education program. The school board supports the philosophy of lifelong learning which honors change and diversity, builds community, develops supports for our educational system, and is the catalyst for collaboration of community resources. The school board welcomes and strongly encourages use of school buildings and activity areas by the community when not used for regularly scheduled early education, elementary and secondary programs. The school administration should strive to accomplish its community education objectives by:

- 2.1 Continually assessing needs and interests of the community.
- 2.2 Developing and implementing community education programs that address the needs and interests of community members throughout their lifetime.
- 2.3 Encouraging active community involvement in program development, implementation and evaluation.
- 2.4 Building strong community-district relationships.
